Fifty Point Conservation Area and marina on Lake Ontario is a magnificent 80-hectare park with superb marina facilities in Stoney Creek. It's the place to be for a swim in Lake Ontario, family camping or a picnic for groups of any size.

Marina facilities at Fifty Point have earned the "5 Green Anchor Award" from the Clean Marine Program, the Green Marine Environmental Award from the Canadian Safe Boating Council and is a member of the Ontario Marine Operators Association.
